The Traisental wine region lies 60 kilometers to the west of Vienna and is influenced by the two climatic zones of the Pannonian basin and the Alps.

Cool winds from the nearby Alps meet with the warm air currents from the Danube Valley. This can lead to extreme differences in the day and night temperatures which are ideal for the development of the aromas in the grapes. The climate and unique calcareous soils in this region are perfect for the production of bright, pale coloured, aromatic wines which are full of character.

The traditional grape varieties of the region are Grüner Veltliner and Riesling.

In our modern winecellar, traditional methods are honoured and enhanced with modern technology to produce the best wines possible.
